## Fast Facts 1<sup>st</sup> John 5:1-3 #17

- 1. John, in various verses (2:9, 3:9, 4:7), spoke about being born of God. Now in one verse of this chapter, he tells us how one is born of God.
- 2. Whoever believes that Jesus is his Christ this means believing that Jesus is his Messiah, not just the messiah in a generic sense.
- 3. John's emphasis has been on love, but you cannot earn salvation by loving others. We are born of God when we trust on Jesus and His saving works in our lives.
- 4. In verses 2-3, we see the demonstration of God's love. Surely John had Jesus in mind from his gospel in John 14:15, "If you love Me, keep My commandments". Simply put love for God will show itself in obedience.
- 5. His commandments are not burdensome. When we are born again, we are given new hearts/new natures, which now by instinct want to please God.
- 6. Now under the new covenant, the law of God is written on our hearts. God prophecied this long ago. Please read Jeremiah 31:31-34.
- 7. And His commandments are not burdensome, compare them to some that various religious gurus come up with today. The Pharisees said you could walk a mile on the Sabbath, but one foot over you had violated the Law.
- 8. Some think by doing nothing on the Sabbath that will please God. In Mark 2:23-27, Jesus is accused of breaking the Sabbath by pulling grain stalks and eating as he walked. Jesus replied, "The Sabbath was made for man not man for the Sabbath".
- 9. John is saying in these verses: Love God; Love others.
